WE DON'T LIKE DRUNKS EITHER

The Western Australian hotel and hospitality industry welcomes and endorses Federal Government initiatives to change binge drinking culture and behaviour.

Bars, hotels and licensed venues don't like drunks either and heavily support and promote the responsible sale, service and consumption of alcohol.

The Australian Hotels Association CEO Bradley Woods says every year the AHA trains thousands of staff in the responsible service of alcohol and liquor licensing laws,

"The hotel industry has been promoting and practicing the responsible service of alcohol for a long time and now welcomes this new initiative to educate the community," he said

"Australian attitudes towards binge drinking need to change, and that process should start at home with parents, so that by the time young people are of adult age they understand appropriate responsible conduct for when they are in licensed premises,"

"Many parents are unsure of how to deal with the issue of binge drinking, or how to educate their children about responsible consumption of alcohol,"

"Public education is well overdue on this issue, and we want to see more resources directed to changing the culture of drinking.." Mr Woods said

The AHA has made its expertise and knowledge available to the Federal Government to support this new campaign on binge drinking.
