

	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): Violent, disorderly and argumentative behaviour is not permitted at this venue – OA3918</b> Suitable for licensed venues – It is against the law for us to allow behaviour that is violent, disorderly, argumentative.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): It is an offence for a juvenile to be in possession of liquor in a public place – OA3919</b> Suitable for licensed venues – It is against the law for juveniles to be in possession of alcohol in a public place. Penalty of \$2,000.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): It is against the law to allow the possession or consumption of liquor by a juvenile on the premises – OA3920</b> Suitable for licensed venues – It is against the law to allow possession or consumption of liquor by a juvenile on the premises. Penalty of \$10,000.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): It is against the law to show false or misleading ID – OA3921</b> Suitable for licensed venues – It is against the law to show false or misleading ID.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): It is against the law for anyone to sell or supply alcohol to a person under 18 years of age – OA3922</b> Suitable for licensed venues – It is against the law for anyone to sell or supply alcohol to a person under 18 years of age.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): No Photo ID No Entry – OA3923</b> Suitable for licensed venues – No Photo ID, no entry. Acceptable forms of ID.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): It is against the law to help a drunk person obtain or consume alcohol on licensed premises or regulated premises – OA3924</b> It is against the law to help a drunk person obtain or consume alcohol on licensed or regulated premises including penalties.	30	








	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): It is against the law to sell or supply liquor to a drunk person – Refusal of service – OA3925</b> It is against the law to sell or supply alcohol to a person who is drunk.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): Sell or supply liquor to a drunk person – Definition of a drunk person – OA3926</b> It is against the law to sell or supply liquor to a drunk person - speech, balance, coordination or behaviour appears to be noticeably impaired.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): It is against the law to sell or supply liquor to a person who is drunk – Penalties - OA3927</b> It is against the law to sell or supply alcohol to a person who is drunk including penalties.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): If you are asked to leave this venue – OA3928</b> Failure to comply with request to leave premises and vicinity is an offence. Penalty \$2,000.	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): Our primary service is the provision of food - OA3969</b> The sale and supply of liquor to patrons is restricted to table service	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): An approved manager is on duty at all times at this venue - OA3970</b> Penalty \$10,000 to the licensee	30	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): Can you afford the risk? OA3971</b> Fines of up to \$10,000 for any person who supplies alcohol on licensed premises to anyone under 18 years of age	20	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): If you look under 25 we will ask you for ID – OA3972</b> If you look under 25 years of age, we will ask you for ID	20	
	<b>Responsible Service Poster (A3): Potable drinking water is free: it's the law – OA3973: Penalties</b>	20
